## **Crime Prevention**



To gain the Crime Prevention badge you must complete one task from each of A, B and C.

## A. INVESTIGATE

- 1. Explain to your Patrol the avenues of reporting crime to Police.
- 2. Complete a set written assignment giving brief answers in relation to laws in your state.

## **B. SKILL**

- Engrave all items of value in your home with your surname and parent's license numbers, with the assistance of one of your parents.
- 2. Design a proforma and list all items of value in your home detailing serial numbers, colours, make, models, and age of the items.
- 3. Enrol your family in Neighbourhood Watch or similar organisation as a means of improving your neighborhood's safety.

## C. ACTIVITY

- Contact your local Neighbourhood Watch organization or similar organization which could provide you with a number of
  engravers to assist Troop members engrave items of value in their home. This will assist Police in the retrieval of items if
  stolen, and help to prosecute offenders.
- 2. This could involve the area's Neighbourhood Watch leader attending to talk to a group of Scouts applying for the badge. The participants need to show that they have been active for at least three months as registered Neighbourhood Watch members.
